Booking Conditions

Space is very limited and is only available to visitors to the games. The space is exclusive to the hirer, and is not transferable.

In case of a false declaration from the hirer, the contract will be cancelled and any amounts paid will be kept by Blackford Highland Games.

The hirer must be insured. Blackford Highland Games are not responsible for any theft, damage or loss during or after the stay.

To be confirmed, each request must be made using the application form and signed by the person making the booking.

A booking is confirmed only after your application form is returned to you by Blackford Highland Games.

Blackford Highland Games can refuse access to anyone who has not written the booking contract.

CAMPING PITCH-

There is no electricity available to hirers and water and sewerage are accessed off-site.

You must advise us if you're late. Your booking will be kept for 12Hrs after your stated arrival date, after that the booking will be considered cancelled.

Blackford Highland Games can rent the place to someone else if we don't hear from you regarding your delay.

Babies and young children must be included with the number of people on your application form.

Dangerous dogs (as described in the Dangerous Dogs Act 1991) are forbidden. During the games dogs must be on the leash at all times. You must clean up after your dog.

Only 1 car is allowed per pitch.

Please use the waste bins provided and clear up any dog fouling. Your pitch must be kept clean and tidy.

During your stay you may be photographed or filmed for our advertising. Please inform Blackford Highland Games if you do not want to appear in any media.

We don't allow noise on the campsite between the hours of 11pm till 7am. The stewards decision on what constitutes noisy and/or disruptive behaviour is final.

Please respect our park and facilities. Aggressive or challenging behaviour towards our personnel or other visitors will not be tolerated.
